Another purpose of this trip is to engage families in an activity together that helps build the family bond and encourages fellowship with other Christians. These are the discounted group rates. I know this could get expensive for some, but we often spend more for a weekend getaway and this is a spiritual investment! You and your children will learn much from this hand-on experience that will help to prepare you to be set for the defense of the gospel! The means of transportation has not been decided yet, but will likely add to the cost...so start saving for this!
